In a Fix: The Good Repair of Toronto's Social Housing

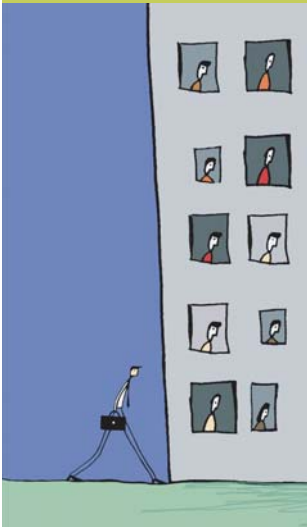
In a Fix describes the capital shortfalls in social housing in the City of Toronto.
